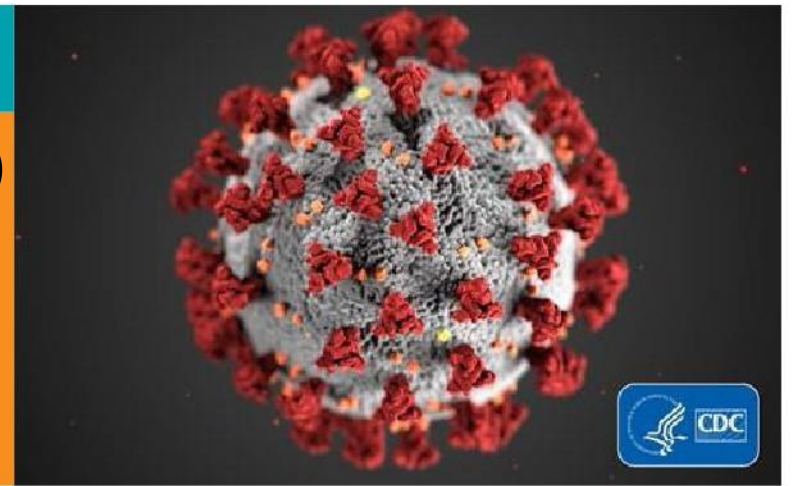


Risk Factors, Signs & Symptoms for COVID-19

- I. Fever **OR** respiratory symptoms (cough, difficulty breathing, cold) OR close contact with a patient with known or suspected Coronavirus COVID-19 in the past 14 days.



Emergency Medical Questions for COVID-19



Incoming call with the following complaints:

- Sick Person
- Fever
- Cough
- Respiratory Illness
- Breathing Problem

Ask the following questions:

1. Ask about signs and symptoms.

- Do you have a fever? ***Has been or is*** greater than 100.4 F?
- Do you have symptoms of lower respiratory illness (cough or difficulty breathing, cold)?

NO

If ALL responses are "NO", continue with standard dispatch procedures. Advise Ambulance and Fire the patient is negative Covid screening

YES

2. Inquire about direct exposure history.

- In the last 14 days before symptoms onset, have you come into close contact with a person that is under Investigation (**PUI**), is being monitored(**PUM**) for or has had a positive confirmed test for Coronavirus COVID-19?

YES

If caller or patient advises that they are a **PUI** or **PUM** advise ambulance and fire of that information **PRIOR TO ARRIVAL AT LOCATION**

YES TO # 1

YES TO BOTH

3. Provide information on patient to responding personnel

- Alert responding providers of potential for patient with ***possible exposure of COVID-19*** before on scene arrival.
- Patients should be advised to meet 911 personnel at the front door **if able**
